

5 SIGNS OF HEAT STROKE

1. RAPID PANTING :

Panting helps to maintain body temperature, but if your pet is panting rapidly then the environment is dangerous.



2. COLOR CHANGES :

The color of the gums and tongue gives the picture of your pet's health. Dark red color means your pet is experiencing heat stroke.



3. DEPRESSION : If your pet is lazy, feeling sleep or not active, check with your vet. Because these may be signs of serious heatstroke.



4. VOMITING / DIARRHEA :

These symptoms occur due to excessive heat in your pet's body. Keep your pet hydrated and call the Vet.



5. UNRESPONSIVENESS :

If your pet doesn't respond to your gestures or looks confused chances are it might be in a coma.
